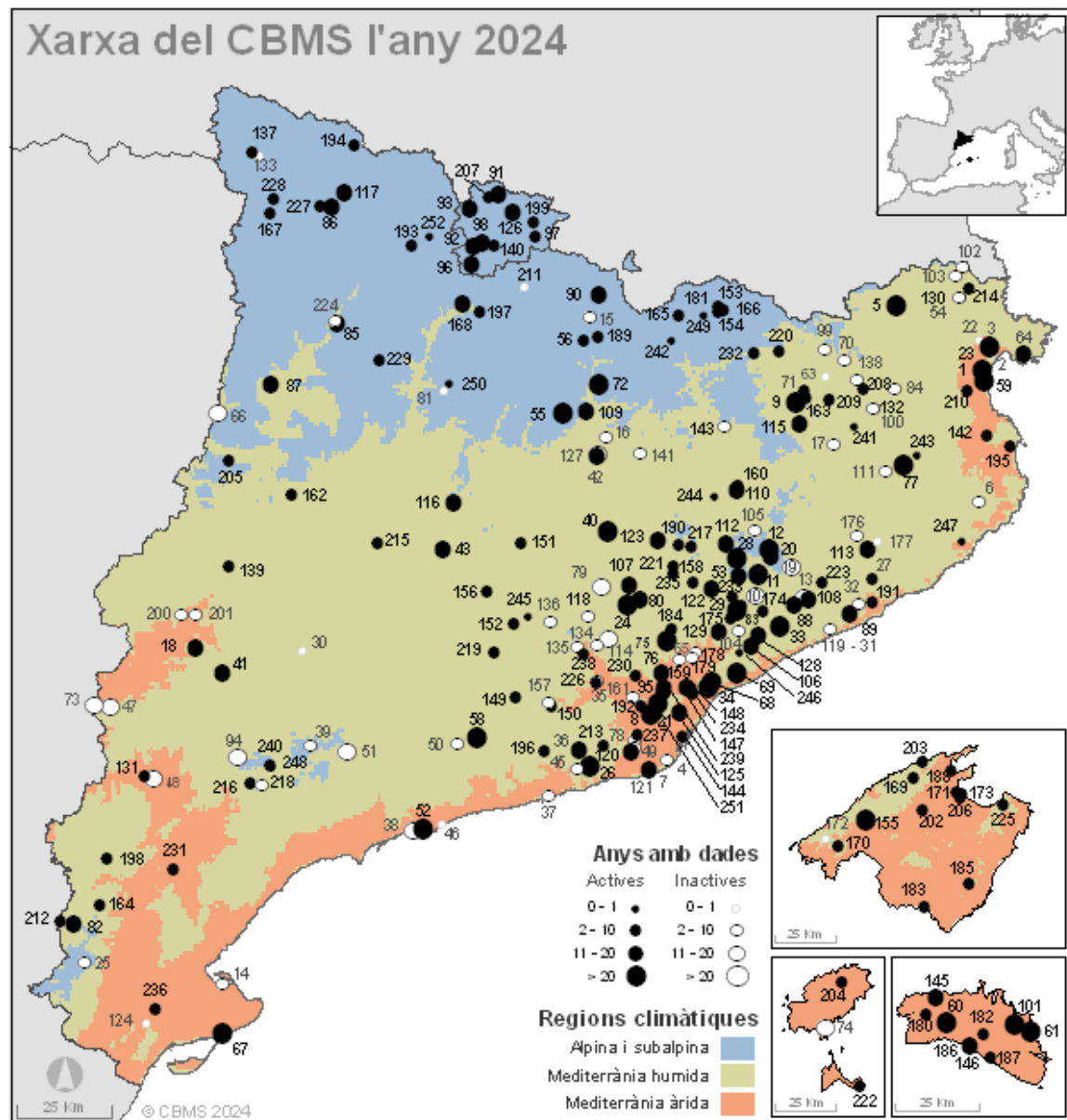

The CBMS: a network for monitoring Mediterranean butterflies



- * Starting in 1994, the CBMS is the oldest monitoring programme based on citizen science in the Mediterranean

- * NE Spain (Catalonia), Balearic Islands, Andorra

- * Until 2024: 252 recording sites and 86,186 km sampled

- * 61,927 h accumulated

- * Approx. 350 volunteers

- * 3,670,018 butterflies of 193 species

- * High diversity of sampled environments
