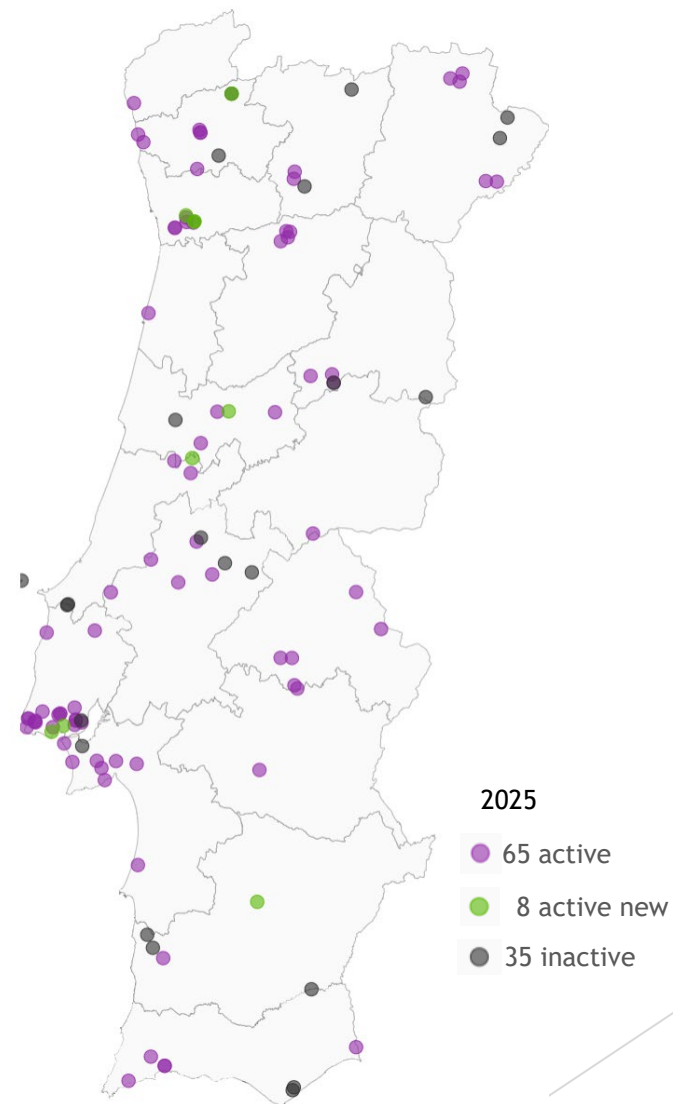

PtBMS 2019 - 2025

- ▶ Active Transects: 11 (2019) - 73 (2025)
- ▶ 108 transects with at least 1 year of sampling
- ▶ No permanent funding
 - ▶ Volunteer Coordination, Engagement and Follow Up, Data Analysis, Reporting & Communication
- ▶ Partnership ICNF
 - ▶ 45 transects (15 inactive)

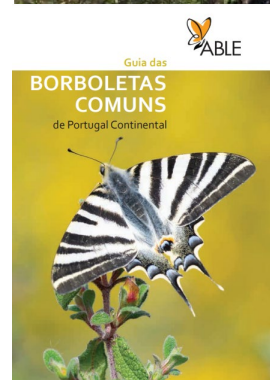

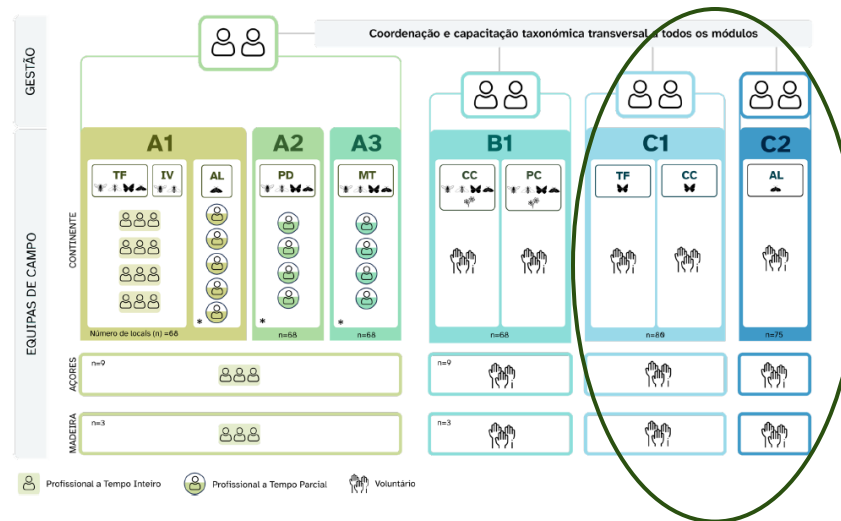

Action Plan for Pollinators



- ▶ University of Coimbra
- ▶ Sep 2023 - Oct 2025
 - ▶ 1st Action Plan for the Conservation and Sustainability of Pollinators
 - ▶ Pt-PoMS proposal
 - ▶ According to NRR & Delegated Act
 - ▶ PtBMS + REBN should be adopted and funded as complementary methodologies



- 220.000 € (12 moths)



Making the case for PtBMS

- ▶ Data
 - ▶ 2019 - 2025
 - ▶ c. 100 transects
 - ▶ 111 sp. / 14 sp. GBI
 - ▶ ~140.000
- ▶ Flight curves by biogeographical areas
- ▶ GBI - compliance with Nature Restoration Regulation
- ▶ Involvement, training & empowerment of different sectors of society (e.g. farmers)
