Project aims

Understand needs and motivations of eBMS recorders to improve their experience, encourage more recording and, in particular, to support the development of templates for personalised feedback to recorders.



Methodology

- Discovery- gathering existing information
- Quantitative data
- Scheme and national coordinator interviews
- Survey to all eBMS recorders



Discovery and interview insight

- Significant variation by country (or region)
- Several major factors determining reception and motivation
 - Cultural/historical (esp attitudes to citizen science, volunteering, EU, being "told what to do")
 - Availability of reference material/field guides
 - Economic/funding
 - Difficulty (species ID, number of species, terrain)
 - Individual



eBMS Survey




- Translated into local languages (thank you!)
- Promoted in all eBMS countries (exc UK and Sweden)
- Open for three weeks
- **1328 responses**
- Challenges: translation and size of survey for qualitative answers
 - Automatic translation of responses into English via Qualtrics and automatic insight






Q3 - Which country do you usually record in?




Q3 - Which country do you usually record in? (ex Netherlands, Spain, Portugal)




Q1- How old are you?

Q4 - Which landscape best describes the one you do more recording in?




Landscape Other (ALL)




Q5 - How many transect visits do you make in a typical year?



Q6 - How many 15 minute counts do you typically do per year?




Q7 - What motivates you to take part in butterfly monitoring? Please rank the following factors in importance where 1 is most motivating.









Insight


- Look beyond the answers e.g. time what could free up time?
- What might apparent contradictions mean?
- Areas relevant to personalised feedback:
 - Motivated by knowing which areas and species need attention
 - Desire to know how data is being used
 - Some interest in all areas, but especially biodiversity of records
 - More interest in self comparison than with others (?)

Next steps

- Cross referencing e.g. investigate if results differ per country/age group/gender
- Refine qualitative data categories
- Full insight report (end of 2025)
